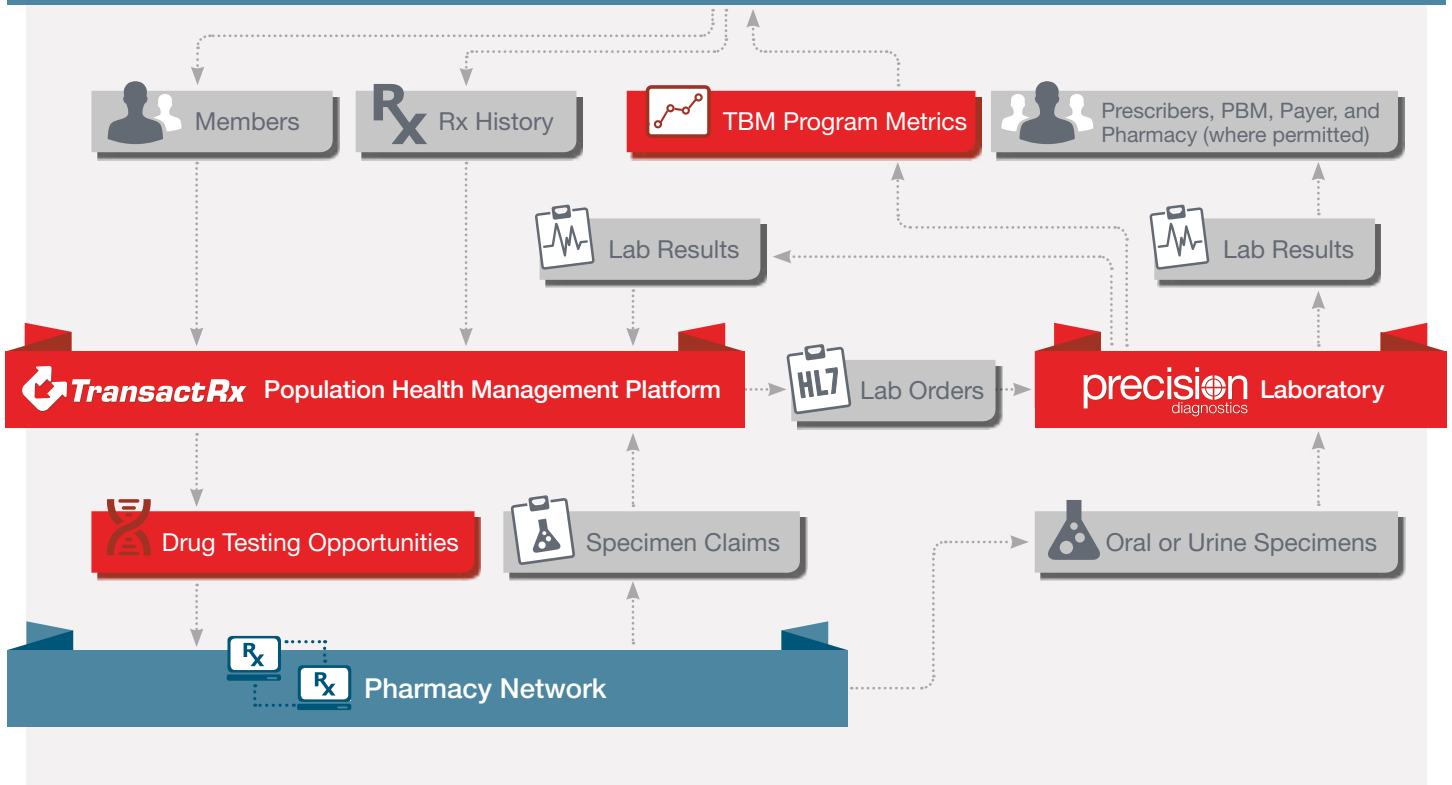
Drug Testing Administered at the Pharmacy to Monitor Patient Compliance Based on Risk Level

TransactRx technology success stories

national medicare Part D payer network

Challenge: Address scale issues created by Medicare moving coverage of preventive vaccines to Part D drug benefit.

Solution: TransactRx worked directly with CMS, along with many Part D payers and PBMs, to create a national Part D provider network for physicians. The TransactRx Cross-Benefit Clearinghouse was implemented to accept medical claims from physician offices and convert them to real-time pharmacy claims to be submitted to Part D Payers via PBMs.

Results: The provider network has contracted with over 30,000 physicians, as well as payers and PBMs representing over 80% of all Part D covered lives. Over a million patients have obtained preventive vaccines.

medical service claims submission for pharmacies

Challenge: Pharmacies have become primary providers of immunizations on a national level. However, influenza vaccines are covered primarily by medical insurance benefits – and pharmacy systems using the NCPDP real-time transaction standard for submitting claims did not have the ability to submit the required X12 batch medical claims.

Solution: TransactRx implemented a solution using its Cross-Benefit Clearinghouse platform to accept real-time NCPDP pharmacy claims directly from the retail pharmacy systems and to convert them to X12 batch medical claims.

Results: To date the solution supports over 1,000 retail pharmacy locations and submits claims to hundreds of medical payers.



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
